Pacific Recorders went ahead with Project using the "Bean"

The last MultiLimiter rolled off the line in 1993, 19 years after the first one
In the fast moving world of Technology, I would consider that tribute to good design

Some say 'other Limiters were louder', not surprising
The MultiLimiter was designed to 'Sound good' and do a creditable job of limiting...

From Time to Time these units show up on Ebay... They don't last long
Folks still use the Multi-Limiter in Recording Studios...
And I would suppose a few are still in the Transmitter Chain!
